#### **A Cooperative Ministry**

Six years ago, Hurricane Michael struck the Florida Panhandle as a category 5 storm with winds peaking at 160 mph. Thousands of homes and businesses on the coast of Florida were devastated.

The church I was serving at the time sent a mission team to Panama City to do home repair. The house had a blue tarp over the roof, and the team spent a week removing moldy ceiling material, wallboard, fans, fixtures and debris from every room. Fortunately, my tetanus vaccination was up-to-date, because I punctured my foot on a nail during this process.

We were not alone in our mission. Our United Methodist team was housed by the Gulf Port Presbyterian Church that offered their church building to accommodate volunteers. The site supervisors worked for AmeriCorps, which is a public service program supported by government, foundation and corporate funds. AmeriCorps Week is March 9-15, 2025.

Then, as now, it is inspiring to watch when our government, businesses, charitable foundations, and churches all come together to make a difference in people's lives.
